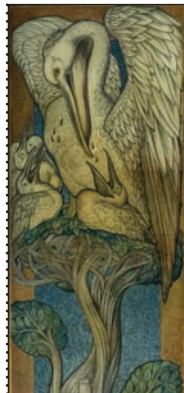

### NOTES

1. You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying the charity.
2. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the charity reclaims on your donations in the tax year. The charity will reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 you give on or after 6 April 2008. The Government will pay to the charity an additional 3p on every £1 you give between 6 April 2008 and 5 April 2011. This transitional relief for the charity does not affect your personal tax position.

4. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
